# Some thoughts on giving...

In Luke 12, Jesus tells them a parable about a farmer with an abundant harvest. He makes plans to care for himself. He speaks these words we have all heard before – v. 19 "Take life easy; eat, drink and be merry." (notice the first word of the next verse!) 20 "But God said to him, 'You fool! This very night your life will be demanded from you. Then who will get what you have prepared for yourself?' 21 "This is how it will be with whoever stores up things for themselves but is not rich toward God."

In Jesus' parable, a man that society would typically laud as an agricultural genius was labeled by God as a fool. Why? Because the man's focus was inward toward himself instead of upward toward God.


