Some thoughts on giving...

Bill Peel wrote an essay entitled "Leadership Is Stewardship." He lays out four important principles about biblical stewardship we must understand:

- 1. The principle of ownership. (2/4/24) 2. The principle of responsibility. (2/11/24)
- 3. The principle of accountability. (2/18/24) 4. The principle of reward. In Colossians 3:23-24 Paul writes: "Whatever you do, work at it with all your heart, as working for the Lord, not for men, since you know that you will receive an inheritance from the Lord as a reward. It is the Lord Christ you are serving." In the Kingdom parables we see that faithful stewards who do the master's will with the master's resources can expect to be rewarded incompletely in this life, but fully in the next. We all should long to hear the master say what he exclaims in Matthew 25:21: "Well done, good and faithful servant!"

As Christians in the 21st century, we need to embrace this larger biblical view of stewardship, which goes beyond church budgets or building projects, though important; it connects everything we do with what God is doing in the world.
