Some thoughts on giving...

Bill Cox has spent over 35 years as an entrepreneur and business owner. He shares "Seven Financial Stewardship Principles for Churches":

<u>1. Prayer and Planning Go Together</u> - Dr. Eugene Peterson gives a great commentary in *The Conversations: The Message Bible with its Translator* contrasting the ways in which the Israelites won the battles of Jericho and Ai. For example, God miraculously collapsed some very thick walls to allow Joshua's army to overtake Jericho. However, after dealing with Achan's sin, God gave Joshua an ingenious plan to defeat Ai.

Sometimes God supernaturally provides financial resources to fund ministry; other times He gives a plan. Similarly, God gave Joseph a miraculous interpretation of Pharaoh's dream that led to Joseph being freed from prison; however, it was Joseph's plan for dealing with the coming famine that brought him promotion. Someone once said that God blesses order and not chaos. It seems reasonable that God is more likely to bless a ministry that proactively and carefully plans the use of their money than one that just spends as funds come in.
